

Your artistic fingerprint in Afghanistan

A unique 3 months opportunity

Our 120 girls and boys age 6 to 17 years old acrobats, singers, actors, jugglers, unicyclists, and roller-skaters in our Kabul centre have been practicing in the last 3-6 years. Our 20 Afghan teachers without any circus education and some help of volunteer circus artists from abroad have been supporting them. Beside some higher level of acrobatics, what we basically need is inspirations, and instructions to utilize what we already have and improve them to a more dynamic organized team to perform fabulous shows. We have a medium and advanced group of performers who perform in schools and for big events and TVs. Working with the advanced group which includes 18 acrobat and juggling boys is our top priority.

Your job will be:

- 1-** Improving acrobatic skills of our 12 best acrobatic boys. This practically means that you must have a good acrobatic background.
- 2-** Working with the 12 acrobatic and 6 juggling boys age 7 to 17 and improving their team work and make them semi professional especially in their attitude and approach to their art. You will transform these 18 boys to well trained well behaved serious artists of a good team who make spectacular performances. This requires your pedagogic and social skills to energize, motivate, organize and train them.
- 3-** Making choreographies and simply putting a spectacular performance with all our children, costumes, props and other ingredients you can find in our centre together to leave a deep impression on the audience.

Training Facilities: we already have nearly all what we need including training gym and many equipment the rest could be prepared.

You will be accommodated (together with us) in our guesthouse inside our circus school centre. The facilities are basic including bed, bathroom, and lunch with our colleagues.

Security: There are dangerous places in Afghanistan but not everywhere and Afghanistan is not as dangerous as it is presented in the mass media. There are many westerns men and women who work in Afghanistan especially Kabul. Our Circus School is in a very safe area of the capital and we have never had any security problems in our 8 years of working and living in Afghanistan.
